# State of Emergency Declaration

**Precautions taken by everyone  
will help us through the crisis !**

In order to stop further spreading of the novel corona virus,  
**please refrain from leaving your house unnecessarily.**

### ◆ Decrease sources of infection !

If you have a fever or fever like symptoms, refrain from going out.

### ◆ Disrupt routes of transmission !

Take steps such as washing/disinfecting your hands thoroughly, cough etiquette etc.

### ◆ Boost your immune system !

Get enough sleep, eat healthy and work out moderately.

### ◆ Don't spread it ! Don't get infected !

Try to avoid the three C's (closed spaces, crowded places, close-contact settings).

Even when you are grocery shopping, go in small numbers.

### ■ In case you have to come to the city hall or branch offices:

Inuyama City tries to attend to all formalities or request via internet or mail.

**Before going to the city hall or branch offices please call** the responsible

Division first. (Depending on your issue/concern it may be necessary for you to go to the city hall.)

## ◆ Closing of public facilities

All public facilities will be closed **until May 31<sup>st</sup>**.

## ◆ Cancellation of Events

All events hosted or joint hosted by the City will be cancelled **until May 31<sup>st</sup>**.

## ◆ If you suspect being infected

If you have the following symptoms please **call** the Consultation Centre for Returnees and Close Contact Persons (*kikokusha sesshokusha sōdan sentā*).

- severe tiredness (physical weariness), shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- flue like symptoms
- fever above 37.5°C (99.5° F) for four consecutive days (elderly or persons with underlying conditions: fever for two consecutive days)

## ◆ To people who are under quarantine at home due to suspicion of being infected with the novel Corona Virus

A support service called *kinkyūji seikatsu shien chīmu* (Team for livelihood support in times of emergency) for grocery shopping, picking up of medicine, checking on your health situation etc. has been set up for people under quarantine at home by order of the Health Care Centre (*hokensho*). Please call if you have difficulties getting support from relatives or other people.
